## ORDINANCE NO. 6

ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF MONTECITO SANITARY DISTRICT ELECTING TO HAVE SEWER SERVICE CHARGES COLLECTED ON THE COUNTY TAX ROLL AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6520.5 of the Health and Safety Code this District has the authority to prescribe, revise and collect fees, tolls, rates, rentals or other charges for services and facilities furnished by it in connection with its sanitation or sewerage systems; and

WHEREAS, Section 5473 of the Health and Safety Code provides that where a Sanitary District has adopted an order pursuant to Section 6520.5, it may, by ordinance approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of its Governing Board, elect to have such charges for the forthcoming fiscal year collected on the tax roll in the same manner, by the same persons and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, its general taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

 All, or any part or portion, of the fees, tolls, rates, rentals, or other charges, including escaped charges or



assessments, which this District may establish for services and facilities furnished by this District in connection with this District's sanitation or sewage system, as provided for in Section 6520.5 of the Health and Safety Code, or any other applicable authority, may, at the discretion of the District, be placed and collected on the tax roll of the County of Santa Barbara in the same manner, by the same person and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, its general taxes. The foregoing procedure is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Article 4 of Chapter 6 of Part 3 of Division 5 of the Health and Safety Code.

This procedure shall commence with fiscal year 1990-91 and shall continue for each subsequent fiscal year until this Ordinance is revoked.

- 2. This Ordinance is declaratory of the intent of Ordinance No. 5.
- 3. With the adoption of this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 5 is hereby repealed.
